• Montessori is a non-graded, self-achievement form of education, which necessitates an uninterrupted, orderly presentation of materials with subsequent activity on the part of the child, at his/her own rate of understanding and performance. Outside pressures such as excessive TV, computer games, and late bedtime may interrupt this program and can leave the child at a disadvantage in terms of understanding and level of achievement.
